BYLAW 1136

A Bylaw to Amend Official Community Plan Bylaw 1070, 2003

The council of the Town of Oliver, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as “OCP Amendment Bylaw 1136.”
2. Official Community Plan Bylaw 1070, 2003 is hereby amended as follows:
 - (1) Section 8.2.1 Social Planning Objectives is amended by adding a new subsection 4 as follows:

“4. Promote the development of quality, accessible and affordable child care and early childhood education that emphasizes a collaborative approach.”
 - (2) Section 8.2.1 Social Planning Objectives is amended by adding a new subsection 5 as follows:

“5. Encourage a range of family support programs based on research and designed to promote family well-being that are accessible, affordable, and innovative and that build on family capacity and community networks.”
 - (3) Section 8.2.2 Social Planning Policies is amended by adding a new subsection 13 as follows:

“13. The Town of Oliver will continue to support community development that supports the health and well-being of families and children.”
 - (4) Section 8.2.2 Social Planning Policies is amended by adding a new subsection 14 as follows:

“14. The Town of Oliver will cooperate with private and public agencies to explore ways to support child care providers in providing quality childcare for families and children.”
 - (5) Section 8.2.2 Social Planning Policies is amended by adding a new subsection 15 as follows:

“15. The Town of Oliver will seek opportunities to collaborate with the Interior Health Authority on programs for families and children.”

(6) Section 8.2.2 Social Planning Policies is amended by adding a new subsection 16 as follows:

“16. The Town of Oliver will continue to support the provision of after-school programming in the local schools and recreation facilities.”

(7) Section 8.2.2 Social Planning Policies is amended by adding a new subsection 17 as follows:

“17. The Town of Oliver will support the Oliver and Area Recreation Commission in accommodating child care services in recreation facilities, where feasible.”

(8) Section 8.2.2 Social Planning Policies is amended by adding a new subsection 18 as follows:

“18. The Town of Oliver will explore, in cooperation with School District 53, ways to preserve and expand the use of school grounds by child care facilities without negatively impacting the school use.”


