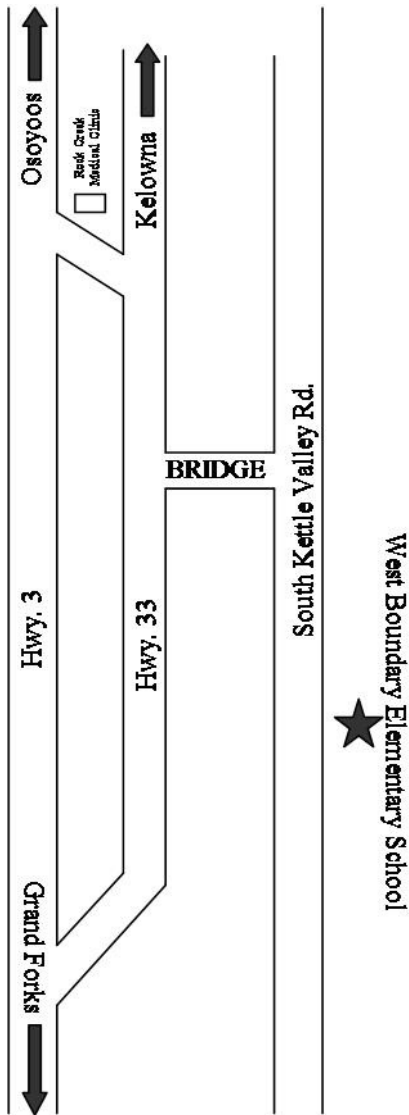


How to Get to the Conference

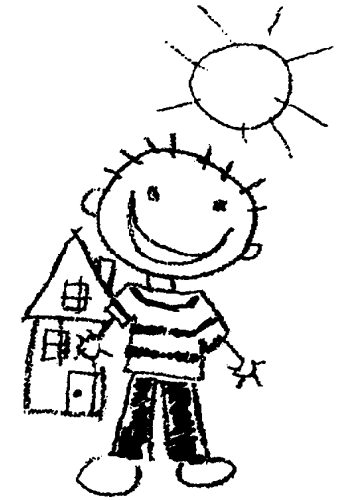
